Grades 5-6

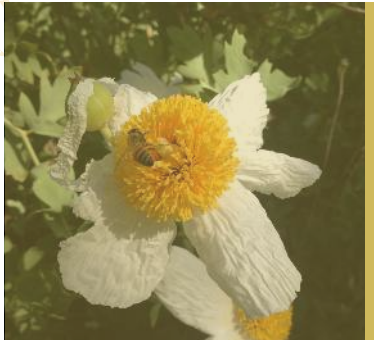
Learn about water quality, healthy habitats and protecting local waterways.
